**PUBLIC HEARING MEETING MINUTES**

**I. Call to Order**

Chairman Foote called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. In attendance were Selectmen, Lawrence B. Foote; Chairman, Charles R. Melvin Sr.; Vice-Chairman, Kathryn Michaels, Matthew A. Burrill, Edvin Crnolic, Town Administrator Nancy J. Wrigley, Selectmen's Secretary Diane M. Morin, and members of the public. Utilizing Zoom Conference Call was Selectman Michaels.

Chairman Foote read the following:

**The Board of Selectmen will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, June 1, 2021, beginning at 7:00pm at the Newton Town Hall, 2 Town Hall Road, Newton, NH and via Zoom Conference Call for the following:**

**To take public input on the acceptance of \$16,852.19 from New Hampshire Department of Safety, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, Public Assistant – CDFA #97.036.**

Deputy Emergency Director McCarthy addressed the Board. She informed the Board that the funds are not from a grant. The funds are from FEMA to reimburse the Town for expenses incurred during the COVID-19 pandemic. This is the first reimbursement payment, and she expects the Town to receive more of these as the EOC submits the paperwork.

**Selectman Melvin moved per RSA 31:95-b to accept and expend \$16,852.19 FEMA reimbursement funds. Seconded by Selectman Burrill with a unanimous vote.**

**Selectman Melvin moved to close the public hearing at 7:06pm. Seconded by Selectman Crnolic with a unanimous vote.**
