Minutes from Previous Meeting of December 19, 2018:

Diane motioned to accept the December 19, 2018 meeting minutes. Bob seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

Unfinished Business: Update from Station Manager

- Jamie has composed a letter that will be handed out to candidates when they sign up to run for an open position. Lisa made some corrections to the letter. The letter will be available at the Town Hall and Sanborn Regional School District Office. A notice will be placed in the Carriage Towne News and on the Town's website.
- Camera Recommendation: Jamie reviewed the 2 options to replace the camcorder used for remote recording. Both cameras are in the mid-range price and would work well for our needs. Jamie recommended that Panasonic camcorder which is on sale for \$847.99. It would require a flash memory card to store the videos on. Jamie recommended a 128G card.

Diane moved to recommend to the Board of Selectmen the purchase of a camcorder and accessories in the amount not to exceed \$1,100.00. The funds to come from the Cable Revolving Fund. Seconded by Bob with a unanimous vote.

• Software Recommendation: Diane reviewed the option Jamie provided to the Committee for video editing and slide creation. The Abode Creative Cloud

Software requires a yearly subscription in the amount of \$239.89. Diane felt that the cost is high for the amount of usage needed. Jamie stated that this software is widely used in Education, Government and the Public Sector. He uses the software to create slides which allows him greater flexibility. The Committee agreed that the software would be worth the cost.

Diane moved to recommend to the Board of Selectmen a 1-year software subscription for Adobe Creative Cloud Software. The current yearly subscription cost is \$239.89. The funds to come from the Cable Revolving Fund. Seconded by Marilyn with a unanimous vote.
