- **New Business:**

- 69 North Main Street: Geilen motions to have site checked for wetland compliance during construction according to State & Local Permits. Town Engineer has agreed to check site for compliance.
- 3 Maple Ave, Newton. Slombo makes motion to Conservation to purchase land at no cost and pay deed and recording fees from the Conservation Fund. Second by Geilen, all in favor.
- Chairman Wilson signed copies of wetland permit for 78 Wilders Grove Rd., (Wetlands expedited permit was submitted)
- Chairman Wilson motion to keep the same Conservation Budget as last year. Slombo second, all in favor
- Geilen makes motion to pay the NHACC Dues of \$350.00 out of the 2019 Dues Line Item, Slombo second and all in favor.

1. Reviewed DES letter re: DES Shoreland Permit Application, Map#2, Lot#4-37- (8 Wilders Grove Rd.) DES has received this application which requests a permit for impacts to jurisdictional shoreland, but was missing several documents. A detailed technical review of the application package must be completed per RSA 483-B:9 This is a non-conforming lot, watch for status updates.
2. Received a Code Violation on Wilder's Grove Road; however it is not a Conservation Issue at this time. Incident report was sent to Code Enforcement.
3. Motion by Slombo to accept the October 3, 2019 minutes as presented, second by Estabrook, all in favor.
4. Wetland expedited permit for 78 Wilders Grove Rd., no comments, permit signed by conservation commission.
