Call to Order by Chairman Wilson, Roll Call Vote, meeting opened at 6:00pm In attendance: Chairman Molly Wilson, Vice Chairman Nancy Slombo, Sandy Estabrook & Alicia Geilen.

Motion by Slombo to allow Alicia Geilen to be a voting member in place of McCarthy Minutes were transcribed by Chairman Wilson.

• New Business:

- 69 North Main Street: Geilen motions to have site checked for wetland compliance during construction according to State & Local Permits. Town Engineer has agreed to check site for compliance.
- 3 Maple Ave, Newton. Slombo makes motion to Conservation to purchase land at no cost and pay deed and recording fees from the Conservation Fund. Second by Geilen, all in favor.
- Chairman Wilson signed copies of wetland permit for 78 Wilders Grove Rd., (Wetlands expedited permit was submitted)
- Chairman Wilson motion to keep the same Conservation Budget as last year. Slombo second, all in favor
- o Geilen makes motion to pay the NHACC Dues of \$350.00 out of the 2019 Dues Line Item, Slombo second and all in favor.

• Correspondence:

- 1. Reviewed DES letter re: DES Shoreland Permit Application, Map#2, Lot#4-37- (8 Wilders Grove Rd.) DES has received this application which requests a permit for impacts to jurisdictional shoreland, but was missing several documents. A detailed technical review of the application package must be completed per RSA 483-B:9 This is a non-conforming lot, watch for status updates.
- 2. Received a Code Violation on Wilder's Grove Road; however it is not a Conservation Issue at this time. Incident report was sent to Code Enforcement.
- 3. Motion by Slombo to accept the October 3, 2019 minutes as presented, second by Estabrook, all in favor.
- 4. Wetland expedited permit for 78 Wilders Grove Rd., no comments, permit signed by conservation commission.
- Motion by Wilson to adjourn at 6:51pm, second by Estabrook, all in favor.
