- Camara's, security update: We have completed viewing on companies security system And will be visiting another one on 10/7/22. So our updated report will be at your next meeting on The 18^{th.}
- Filter's for Town Hall and Library: ARPA work-group has a quote for portable filters for town hall and library for \$5390.55. (10 units) . UV systems would have been more expensive.
- Recreation Dept: ARPA funds(if available) will be used to expand Greenie Park and parking lot. The hope is to take down some trees at the edge of parking lot and expand lot.
- Solar Company will be meeting with us on the 3rd week of October with prices. We are also waiting for the confirmation that ARPA money can be used for this. Last meeting ARPA Work-group reported out about the usage at the library being high. We discovered three things that attributed to that, and it has now been rectified.
- We have the potential to get a 4x4 truck through a state bid process from Liberty Chevrolet for \$75,682.61. We are waiting for confirmation on using ARPA money for this
- The batteries for the mobile message board sign were failing so we have approved buying new ones.
