Meeting Started at 11am Discussed the following:

1. This week the AED's are being placed into service. Any Department that had an old one will be replaced with a new one. The new AED's are too large to fit in the old cases, so we need to purchase new ones for the following locations: Town Hall, Police Dept, Fire Dept & Transfer Station. Unanimous vote to recommend to selectmen to allow Deputy Kane to purchase four cabinet/cases for the AED's, not to exceed \$1000.00.
2. Chief Jewett advised that the security camera installation is still moving forward and will keep us in the loop. Discussed the need to camera's at the transfer station. There have been some issues with illegal dumping and the current camera's couldn't produce a clear photo. Chief Jewett will send the Seacoast Team to the Transfer Station to assess the current camera's and provide other options.
3. Discussed the mobile office/construction trailer for the Transfer Station. Eagle leasing was contacted, and they also suggested a separate "Large/Bathroom" set up another construction trailer for the office. It was also discussed to contact Dan Doyle at the High School to ask about the status of the portable trailer at the Memorial school. McCarthy will let us know the outcome.
4. Discussed the Generator Install at the Transfer Station. Kozec will continue to take the lead on this and get a price from Haffner on the install. He will keep us informed.
5. Fire Dept Rescue Boat status is about a month or so out for delivery. Chief Alcaidinho went to see it and finalize the details on arch and painting. The arch will have to be modified to fit the smaller boat, and the company will split the cost with the Town, also the lettering will be an additional cost of about \$145.00. ARPA committee agrees with what has to be done.
