


Hepatitis A

Hepatitis A is a virus that can cause liver infection. The virus is spread easily person to person.

How is it spread?

When a person ingests the virus from objects, food, or drinks contaminated by small amounts of stool from an infected person.



Who is at risk?

- Anyone can get infected •
- with Hepatitis A, but people at
 - higher risk include: •
- Men who have sex with men
- People with Substance Use Disorder
 - People experiencing homelessness
 - People with recent jail stay

Prevent the Spread

- Wash your hands frequently and especially after bathroom use or before food preparation
- Avoid sex with someone who has Hepatitis A infection
- Don't share personal items, food, drinks, or smoking devices with others
