NOTICE OF DECISION

The application submitted by **Gino & Barbara DiVecchia** of Wilmington, MA for relief from *Section XV* - **Residential A Zone Area Regulations, Subsection 3: Location on lot** for their property at *27 Wenmark's Road, Newton, NH*, referenced as *Tax Map 2, Block 2, Lot 6* received a variance, to wit: allowing the applicants a 7-foot reduction to the side yard setback on the westerly side and a 37.2-foot reduction to the centerline of the road setback, as shown on the plan dated 8/26/2021 and amended on 6/3/22 (as corrected), by a **Unanimous** vote of the Zoning Board of Adjustment on *August 3, 2022*.
